Mega Trains

From Saturday 11 February at 18:00

All over the world, there are trains carrying extraordinary loads. Some of them prevent the economic isolation of remote territories, some bring together two countries or peoples, and others brave the elements and cross hostile environments. Yet more carry dangerous materials or transport goods that are essential to a country. These trains make a vital difference to the everyday lives of thousands of women and men. In the Mauritanian desert, a train more than 2.5 kilometers long winds between the dunes carrying 22,000 tons of iron ore, the country's main source of wealth. Meanwhile, in Canada, 45 freight cars cross the 1,000 kilometers that separate Prince Rupert and Whittier, Alaska, in all weather. Adventure is always just around the corner, but danger can loom at any second.



The Island with Bear Grylls

From Tuesday 14 February at 21:00

Survival expert Bear Grylls returns for another season and has abandoned 16 British men and women on a remote island with only the clothes on their back and rudimentary tools. Marooned separately in all-male and all-female teams on opposite sides of the island, the two groups will need to find each other to improve their chances of survival. Will army veteran Hannah's training prepare her for the rigours of life on the island? Meanwhile Rizwan, on the men's team, hopes the challenge will be a turning point in his life. The island might look like paradise but the dense jungle is home to potentially deadly creatures – will they be able to find food and water and create shelter to survive the month?

Wheeler Dealers

From Wednesday 1 February at 21:00

Experienced car dealer Mike Brewer and multi-talented mechanic Edd China are back in action, finding and restoring faded iconic cars to sell for a profit. In each episode, Mike sets out to find a motor with money-making potential that he can hand over to Edd to restore back to its former glory. There's plenty of tension as Edd faces cars that are often decades old, and Mike's desire to score profit increases the risk of mechanical trouble. Amazing transformations include the 1963 Sunbeam Alpine – a classic British sports car and the first James Bond car to hit the screens, and the powerful and luxurious 1983 Mercedes 500 SEC. Can the boys return these cars, and more, to their former glory and still eke out a profit?
