## Todd Sampson's Body Hack

**From Tuesday 23 May at 22:00**

Adventurer Todd Sampson is on a mission to investigate some extraordinary people from around the world to see what we can all learn from their lives. In this six-part documentary series he'll live with hunter-gatherers in Africa, test his endurance with the French Foreign Legion, work as a Sherpa in the Himalayas, and learn traditional free-diving. In the first episode he'll train with mixed martial arts coaches to see if it's possible to become a competent fighter – all in just two weeks. Can he step into their shoes and learn to manage the body's response fear and stress? By pushing his mind and body to the limit he will try to prove that the human body can adapt to just about anything.



## Cooper's Treasure

**From Sunday 28 May at 22:00**

In the 1960s, the "Original 7" astronauts were both rock stars and daredevils. With movie star looks and a penchant for sports cars, Gordon Cooper was the youngest and the flashiest of the bunch. As a space pioneer, he set a record that still holds today for the longest solo space flight in US history. During one of his key missions, while Gordon claimed to be scouring the globe for nuclear sites, he discovered something else: shipwrecks. Working for decades in secret and using information he collected while orbiting Earth, Gordon created a document that he thought could lead to unimaginable wealth – a treasure map from space – and before his death, shared it with his long-time friend Darrell Miklos. This series unravels the truth and the treasure as Darrell embarks on a personal quest to fulfil his friend's legacy.
