Grave Secrets

From Saturday 3 June at 22:00

This haunting true crime series delves into police investigations where all is not as it originally seemed. What happens when a murder investigation exposes the truth that lies behind the white picket fences and reveals everyone from jilted lovers to scheming spouses and strange neighbours? When a wife and mother seemingly commits suicide, a revelation during the autopsy stuns detectives and rocks the community. And when a woman seems to be the unhappy victim of an accidental death detectives are ready to settle the case until the medical examiner finds latent wounds. Featuring interviews with police investigators and witnesses, each episode unravels the layers of secrets around each victim, until only one thing is certain... that no secret can stay buried forever.



Paranormal Lockdown

From Saturday 10 June at 22:50

Paranormal all-star Nick Groff and ghost hunter Katrina Weidman host this thirteen-episode series that stretches the limits of paranormal investigations. In each episode, the pair confines themselves to some of the most terrifying places in the world for 72 hours straight. Living in haunted locations, Groff and Weidman believe the longer they stay, the more chance they have that the local spirits will communicate with them, allowing them to gather more information about the unknown. They tackle the trauma behind a colonial manor in Massachusetts, the horror stories behind Shrewsbury Prison in England, and try to learn the truth behind a shadowy presence in the St Ignatius Hospital halls in Washington. Using state of the art high-resolution cameras and never-before-seen paranormal technology, they collect surprising new images and sounds. But the mission comes with risks: alone, exhausted, mentally broken, they'll be vulnerable to whatever lies within.



Casey Anthony: An American Murder Mystery

From Tuesday 13 June at 22:00

On July 15th 2008, a 911 call reporting a missing child sparks an intense investigation. Orlando police are desperate to find two-year-old Caylee - but her mother, Casey Anthony, seems to be standing in the way of their search. This three-part documentary special goes deep inside the case that shocked the United States. Featuring detailed interviews with Caylee's grandparents, Cindy and George Anthony, this series peels back layers of family dysfunction and reveals details surrounding the troubled investigation and trial that sparked outrage across the country. Interviews with senior police officers involved as well as dramatic re-enactments of key moments of the investigation reveal the lies and betrayal in this extraordinary case.



Murder Calls

From Wednesday 21 June at 22:00

Featuring chilling and terrifying real-life 911 calls, this documentary series lifts the lid on seemingly picture-perfect lives and reveals the shocking truths about violent crimes. Juxtaposing recordings of the victims' emergency calls against dramatic re-enactments and testimony from witnesses and investigators, each episode offers the opportunity to analyse how and why the victims of violent crimes suffered their fate. From the harrowing call in which a terrified woman gives police clues to her whereabouts before she is later found dead to the series of 911 calls in which a serial killer confesses his crimes, this series reveals how quickly good times can turn fatally bad.
