The Rarest Boy In The World focuses on two-year-old Aidan Smith, who suffers the extremely rare genetic disorder Cloves Syndrome, and attempts by his parents to find treatment. In The Boy Who Wants His Leg Cut Off, Dillon Chapman has an extreme form of Neurofibromatosis (NF1) and has over 200 tumours growing within his small body – for him, amputation is the best course of action.
